



Hospital Outpatient Surgery Instructions

Outpatient surgery patients should report to the Surgery Center Registration Desk. Enter the hospital through the Education entrance, the Surgery Center will be to your left.

Please bring your Insurance card, your Driver's license or photo identification, and a list of your current medications.

You may have nothing to eat or drink after midnight the night before your surgery. Take your medications as scheduled with a small sip of water.

Notify your surgeon of and changes in your physical condition.

Do not wear any make-up, nail polish, or jewelry to the hospital. Do not apply any lotions, creams, oils or deodorants.

Do not bring any valuables with you.

Wear loose comfortable clothing.

After your surgery, you should not ingest any alcohol for 24 hours. You may not drive until instructed to do so by your physician.

Pre-testing will be performed 3 – 7 days prior to surgery. This may include lab work, X-rays etc. If your physicians office has not scheduled your appointment, you may call (770) 991-8144 to schedule your own appointment.
